That we may be filled with the joy of the Risen Christ and, in turn, be joyful witnesses of Fransalians in our lives and missions. We pray to the Lord.

From the Provincial's Desk

Christos Anesti! – “Christ is risen; Truly he is risen!” With this traditional Easter proclamation of the Churches of the East, I greet you on this Easter Sunday. In the resurrection narratives, we read that, an angel of the Lord rolled back the stone (Mt 28:2). The removal of the tombstone did not mean, it enabled Jesus to come out of the tomb, for he had already risen, but it paved way for the women (Mk 16:5) and the disciples (Jn 20:6-8) to enter into the tomb, so that they might *see and believe* that the body of Jesus is no more there and that he is truly risen. The rolling of the stone was intended to lead them to an intense, formidable belief in Jesus. Removal of stone is sufficient for a deeper faith in God. May we prepare ourselves to let the stone of separations be rolled away, so that we can enter into a new relationship with God and with one another.

The removal of the stone is followed by an invitation “come and see,” reminding us of the invitation of Jesus at the start of his ministerial life, extended to the disciples of John the Baptist, who asked him “Rabbi, where are you staying?” (Jn 1:39). It was an invitation to come and stay with him. Consecrated life is a replica of staying with Jesus. The invitation at Easter, is to bear witness to the presence of Jesus amidst the living and no more in the darkness of the tomb. Community life offers us the chance to identify His presence in the confreres. It is possible that we do not pay attention to the stone removed from the tomb and we continue to look for Jesus, the crucified. We are tempted to mourn the dead and decayed deeds of others, weep over the pain inflicted upon us, try to be vindictive, and cry over the missed opportunities. This invitation to “come and see” is coupled with another exhortation, “go and tell” (Mt 28:10). The new reconciled relationship is to be extended to others who are willing to enter into this way of life. Easter calls us to *come and see* that the life has changed and *go and tell* others that we have seen Jesus in our lives. May we discover the joy of the risen Lord in our community life and have a foretaste of the beauty of heaven. *Christos Anesti!* And we seek Him, who lives amidst us. He is the Lord of our lives. Happy Easter!

Permanent Delegate of the Provincial Superior

In accordance with the amended article 233, and in consultation with the Provincial Council which met on 25th January 2024, I, hereby nominate Rev. Fr. A. Edward as the Permanent Delegate of the Provincial for the current term. He will function in the absence of the Provincial, to take care of the duties designated by the Provincial with delegated powers.

Article 233. Once the provincial administration is in place, in consultation with his council, the Provincial nominates one of his councillors, other than the Admonitor as his permanent delegate who will act on his behalf, in case of his absence or prolonged incapacity. If such a situation lasts more than three months, he is to refer the matter to the Superior General.

On behalf of the Province, I congratulate Rev. Fr. A. Edward and wish him God's abundant blessings.

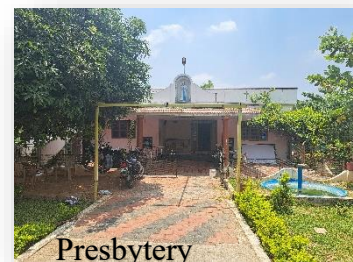

News about St. James Parish, Kullarayanpalayam



Province has taken over the parish now. The parish is situated in Palakkad District, Kerala, bordering Tamilnadu. It is about 26 km away from Pollachi and 38 km from Coimbatore. The parish has about 210 families. It is a parish which consists of only one main station, without any substations. Besides the Parish Church and

St. James Parish, Kullarayanpalayam was erected in 2017 in the diocese of Sultanpet and was entrusted to the Nagpur Province of the MSFS. We have been collaborating with Nagpur Province in sharing the pastoral administration in the parish. Fr. X. Vincent, Fr. S. Christuraj and Fr. Nayagaseelan rendered their service as parish priests. Our



the presbytery, the parish also has 30 cents of land which is now used for cultivation. Fr. X. Vincent was the first parish priest at Kullarayanpalayam. The parish has a good presbytery, constructed by the MSFS in 2017. In the same year, the new Church was also constructed. Both these works were completed when Fr. S. Christuraj was the parish priest. A fencing was done in 2020; Paver block was laid around the Church in 2021; the church-bell and flagpole were installed in 2022 during the tenure of Fr. Nayagaseelan as the parish priest. Fr. Sheen and Fr. Michael Raja took charge in May 2023 as the parish priest and assistant parish priest respectively and are building up the faithful. Our sincere thanks to Nagpur Province for its initiatives in this parish. We thank Fr. Muthusamy John Britto, the former Provincial of Nagpur Province and Rev. Fr. Manoj Tirkey, the Provincial of Nagpur Province and the fathers who worked in Kullarayanpalayam for their great contribution towards forming the faithful in this parish.

Annual Retreat Group II - 2024



The Annual Retreat for the group - II of our Province was arranged at Prasanth Vanam (Cluny Sisters), Kalapet in Pondicherry from 14th to 19th January. Our confreres started arriving at the Retreat Centre on the 14th evening. The retreat centered around the theme “Imperfection to Integration.”

There were 44 participants. Fr.

A. Patrick Jayaraj, the Provincial of

SEIP, introduced the retreat preacher Rev. Fr. Suresh Raj, OFM (Cap.). The timetable for the retreat was planned out well which included Novena to St. Francis de Sales during morning prayer. The preacher took a Psycho - Spiritual approach to guide us from Imperfection to Integration: - We have a double vocation - vocation to religious life and vocation to priesthood. Just as the Lord called all the prophets and various prominent personalities in salvation history, he calls each one of us for a specific purpose. Therefore, we need to place ourselves before God. God keeps revealing himself to us in all circumstances, and so we need to become aware of his message for each of us. Explaining the eschatological dimensions of Jesus Christ (Our Religious Vows), Fr. Suresh OFM graphically explained that,

1. We rise to the freedom from limited relationships to unlimited relationships.
2. We rise to manifest God’s universal love to humankind.
3. We rise to generate spiritual sons and daughters.

Through his psycho-spiritual approach, the preacher explained how the Lord removes our mental, spiritual and psychological blocks, unties our evangelical knots and integrates the right blending of mind and heart leading to happier life in the midst of our everyday life struggle. This retreat

offered us a lot of impetus which is helpful in the transformation of life, moving from imperfection to Integration. The provincial, in his final thanksgiving note, exhorted us to carry Jesus and our Blessed Mother in our hands for the success of our ministry.

Neighbourhood Communities

Dear confreres, we, as a religious congregation, strive to live our religious life in and through community living. The words of St. John Paul II encourage our efforts to live in communities. “The Church wishes to hold up before the world the example of communities in which solitude is overcome through concern for one another, in which communication inspires in everyone a sense of shared responsibility, and in which wounds are healed through forgiveness, and each person's commitment to communion is strengthened” (*Vita Consecrata*, 45). Our Constitution, article 80 calls community life as an essential element of our religious consecration and demands that each one belongs to a properly constituted community. We live in canonically erected religious houses. However, due to the nature and scope of our ministry and pastoral demands, unfortunately some of us are staying alone. The Canon Law and our Constitutions come to aid in such a context. “A confrere, who has to live alone owing to his apostolic commitment or other serious reasons (Canon 665.1), belongs to and is obliged to remain in close communion with the nearest Local Community.” Const. 256 describes that a community consists of two or more confreres having the same residence, or confreres living in proximity and constituted as a community. Kindly note that having a confrere who is in formation (eg. regent or deacon), who is only temporarily assigned to a community, does not constitute an established local community in the strict sense.

In view of facilitating fraternal life among us and as exhorted by our Superior General, we have decided to affiliate the confreres, staying alone in our province to a community, taking the proximity and viability into consideration.

Characteristics of our neighbourhood local communities:

- The superiors of the community will be also responsible for the religious and community life of the affiliated members. They are to invite them for the community meetings and foster collaboration between various ministries. (Const. 79: Our community life is fostered, enlivened and animated by the Superior who is entrusted with the responsibility of promoting cooperation and mutual trust among the confreres. He is called upon to create an atmosphere for religious living in all its aspects – material, spiritual, intellectual, psychological, and apostolic – whereby each member can grow in and experience authentic religious life. It is the duty of the Superior of the Local Community to organize regular community meetings in order to share the concerns of the common mission of the community and of the individual members).
- Besides the monthly community meetings, we are also encouraged to come together for informal gathering, whenever we find an opportunity. Meetings could be organized also in the affiliated places.
- The resident members of the established local communities are to show solidarity with the affiliated members in all their needs. Readiness to share the ministry (eg. by way of being available for replacement when one is absent, sharing in pastoral works etc) and care for

them at times of illness are to be fostered. Taking holidays or being absent from the place is a matter to be communicated to the community through the Superior.

- While the affiliated members retain their independency in their respective ministries, they are exhorted to bring to the knowledge of the Superior and community, of the happenings and developments in their ministries, as the resident members of the communities do, especially at the community meeting.

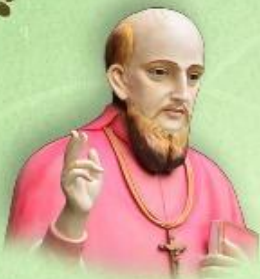
