From the Provincial's Desk

Francis de Sales is a co-pilgrim of Hope in our journey with Jesus. His spirituality pins hope in God and HIS salvific plan for all. He was convinced that the love of God is available to everyone, and that every person is called to Holiness. One of his most important sayings is: "It is a mistake, a heresy, to want to exclude devoutness of life from among soldiers, from shops and offices, from royal courts, from the homes of the married." Strengthened by the virtue of Hope, he, therefore, dedicated himself to preaching the Word of God to others with immense zeal and fortitude. His attitude was characterized by hope which was visible in his approach as a young priest: in the face of great physical danger and hostility, when the doors were slammed in his face and insults were hurled at him from every direction, he remained unfazed.

His episcopal motto "Non Excidet," meaning "HE shall not fail," is highly expressive of Hope. The motto does not put him at the center, but points to God: if we trust in God who is love, He will not fail us. He uses the image of a Compass, a navigation instrument, used to find out directions. It's needle always points to the north whether it is stormy, cloudy, rainy or sunny. It gives the sailor hope even in tough conditions. Likewise, our heart should look towards God and God alone, regardless of the happenings in life. A pilgrim of hope is not merely optimistic, which a secular person can very well be, but he fixes his trust in God in all circumstances. Hope would indicate the involvement of God in our life. It calls us to see the brighter side of a topsytury life situation and have trust in God. It is an attitude that our God will not abandon us, despite our experience of tribulations.

A person of Hope is not a dreamer, but highly realistic. Our Patron was always realistic and human. He says, "I am human as anyone else." This realism is enlivened by hope in God. He says, "To be human is to be rooted in God, for it is God's nature in us that makes us really human." He sees God in everything, especially in all human beings. In one of his letters, St. Francis writes, "God leads the strong with his hand, but carries the weak in his arms." His optimistic approach in life makes him a saint of Hope.

As the Holy Father reminds us that we are all pilgrims of Hope, we move forward with the spirituality of St. Francis de Sales, a saint of Hope, who teaches us to be filled with Hope, to set our hearts on God alone, and trust Him who never fails us. Happy Feast of our Heavenly Patron St. Francis de Sales.

Projects in Malawi Mission

Our community at Livingstonia (Fr. Anantharaj and Fr. Jerald) has constructed a Maize Mill in view of making the community self-reliant. The machineries are already fixed in the new building. We are yet to get the electricity connection, after which the mill will begin to function. The local people contributed to this project through their labour. As of now, the people have to

walk/travel about 25 km in order to grind maize. The new mill in Livingstonia will reduce their burden considerably. We whole-heartedly thank Fr. A. Amalraj who mobilized fund for this project, and the provincial administration for the support.

Our community at Ngerenge (Fr. Nelson and Fr. Marshal) has completed the project of the construction of a store room for the community. Since Ngerenge is a fertile area, conducive to cultivate rice, many farmers are engaged in cultivation of rice and groundnuts. Therefore, newly constructed storeroom will be utilized to store such cereal grains and legumes, which could be later sold with minimum profit. It will support the local community and the parish needs. We thank the provincial administration for the financial support and encouragement. During the construction of the store house, the faithful of St. Martin De Porres parish were very cooperative and they have put in a lot of effort by way of contributing bricks and sand. I thank them, too, for their generosity.
